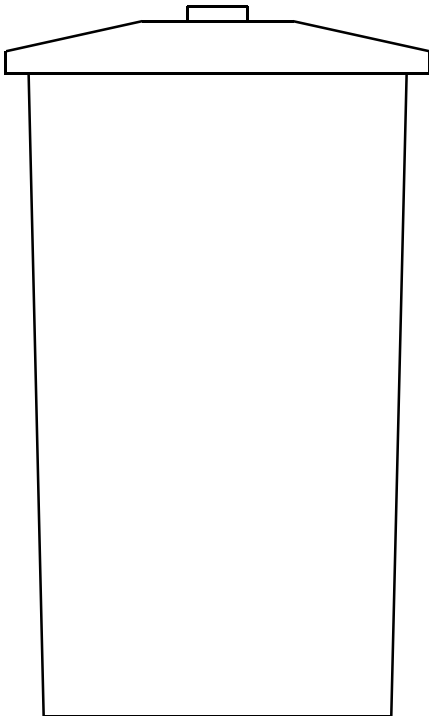


# Making Compost

Compost is rotted, decayed plant material. It provides nutrients which dissolve in water so that plants can take them in through their roots.

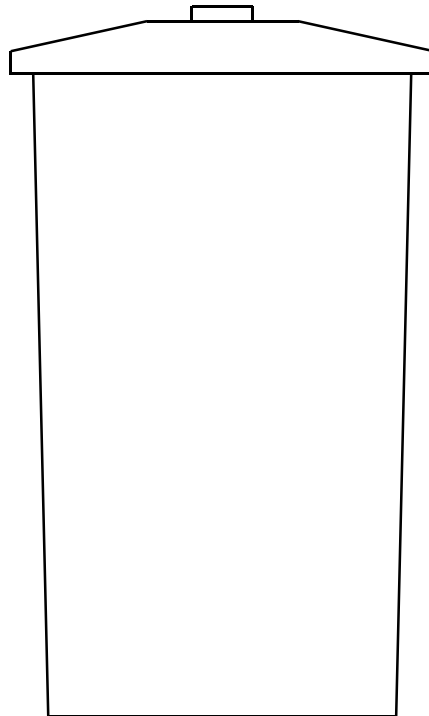
We can compost any uncooked plant parts which have grown in soil and will rot quickly.

Look at the list of items below. Can you sort the rubbish into the correct bins?



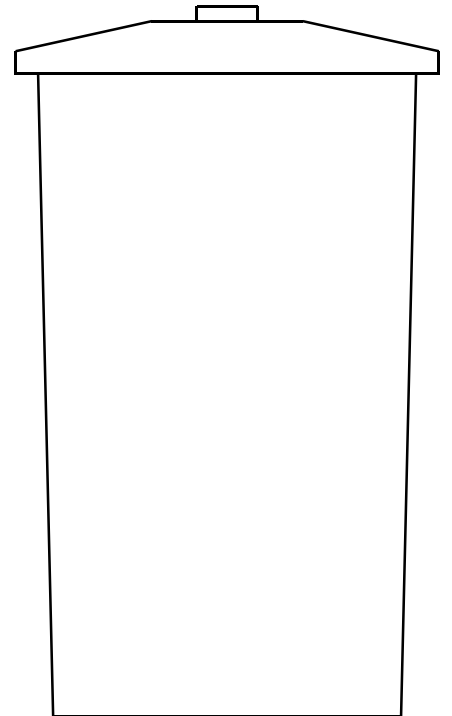
**Compost**
